

Editor's Ethics

- Editor should not show bias in the selection of papers for publication i.e., papers should be published in the order in which they have been approved by the Editorial Committee.
- Editor must be transparent in his/her decision-making-process with respect to the publication of papers i.e., submitting a short report on the status of the paper.
- Papers submitted for review must not be discussed outside of the framework established for publication.
- Editor must ensure that all guidelines provided for the acceptance and publication of papers are followed.
- Editor must not alter the decision pertaining to the publication of a paper once he/she has followed the review process and a decision has been taken.
