Reviewers' Ethics

- Reviewers should not communicate with the researcher on the status of the paper without concurrence of the editorial committee.
- Reviewers are not permitted to discuss the papers submitted outside of the framework established by the Editorial Committee/Advisory Board.
- Reviewers must ensure that due diligence is followed before arriving at a decision on the status of a paper.
- Reviewers must ensure that they have the technical capacity before accepting a paper for review.
- Reviewer should avoid bias in arriving at a decision on the status of a paper submitted for publication.
