Criteria for evaluating the abstract:

- Relevance, significance, and currency of the presentation to the theme and subthemes;
- ✓ Theoretical and practical application of the presentation; and
- Coherence, clarity, and focus of the presentation.

Guidelines:

- 1. Abstract length: 200 to 300 words;
- 2. APA format (7th edition): Times New Roman with font size 12; and
- 3. The abstract should contain the title of the proposed paper, the motivation/ problem statement, the purpose of the study, the conceptual/theoretical framework used, the methodology and methods used, sampling technique used, the findings/results, conclusions/ implications.
