COURSE DETAILS

Grief and trauma are public health issues. This course addresses the need for specialists in the treatment of trauma and grief. It enhances foundational knowledge on grief and trauma, lived experiences of mental health, and core counselling skills in grief and trauma informed care, to empower practitioners to be effective mental health professionals. These include grief and trauma literacy, psychological intervention, creative interventions, and awareness of the impact trauma from exposure to violence, etc., has on health, behaviour, and relationships. This course is not to equip students to treat mental disorders but rather to enter the therapeutic space with a trauma informed lens to help develop appropriate interventions to promote healing, recovery, and resilience, by identifying distinct grief and trauma symptoms apart from depression and other mental disorders in clients.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants are required to possess a Degree in Social Work

OR
in a related Degree in the Social/Behavioural Sciences.

OR
Applicants with a Diploma /Associate Degree in Social Work/Behavioural Sciences would also be eligible to conduct the course along with a minimum of **TWO** Years work experience in the social/welfare service.

CO-REQUISITES:

No Co- requisite or Pre-requisite is necessary for this course. It will be taught as an optional (elective) course throughout the academic year for students at the graduate level.

OR

As a professional development course for individuals who are conducting the course as a special student.
